

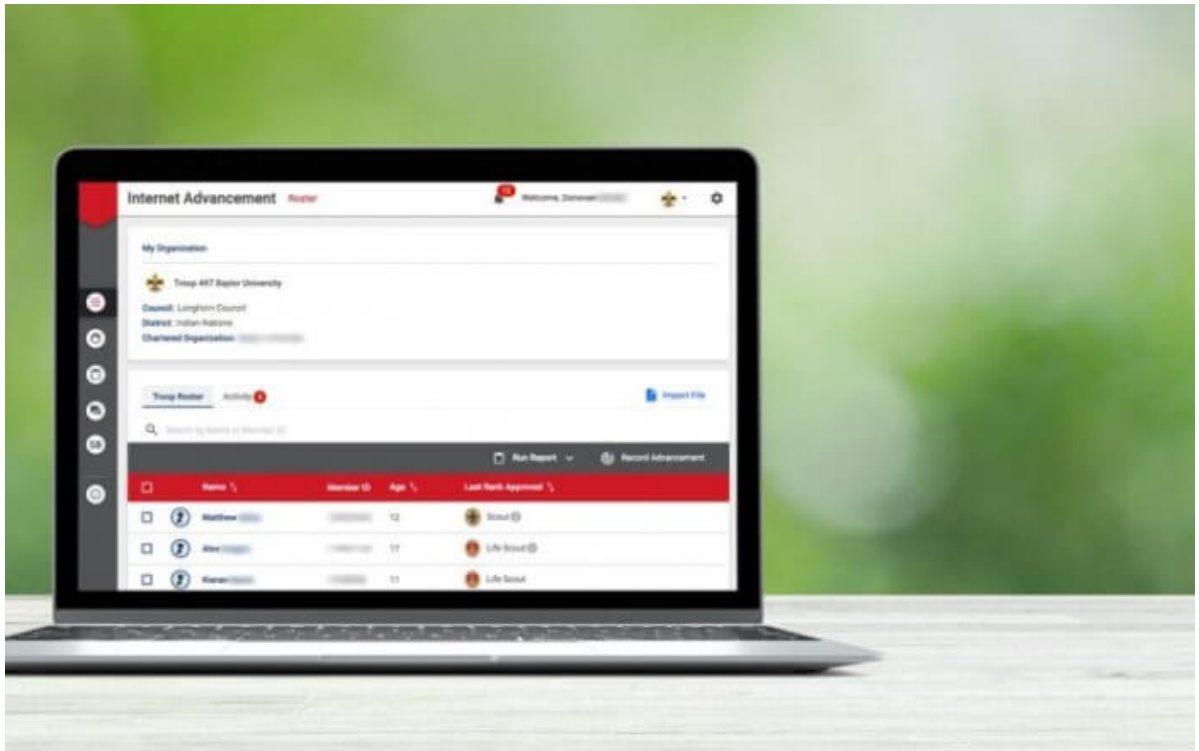

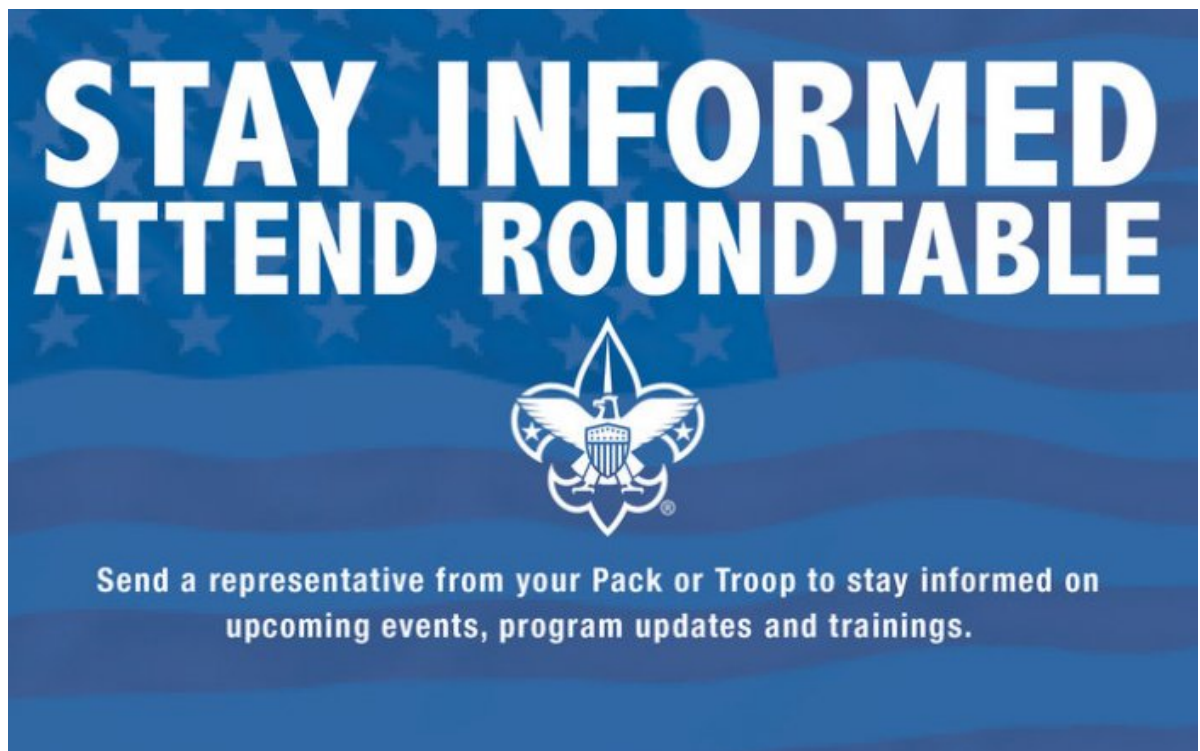
- APPLICATION**: A form with the text "Este solicitud también está disponible en español." and the Boy Scouts of America logo.

- Youth Protection Training**: A text box explaining that all adult applicants are required to take this training in order to complete the adult application process. It instructs applicants to go to my.scouting.org to create an account and take the training online or contact their local council for classroom training. It also states to include a copy of their completion certificate with the application.
- Mission**: A text box stating the mission of the BSA is to prepare young people to make ethical and moral choices over their lifetimes by instilling in them the values of the Scout Oath and Scout Law.
- Excerpt From the Declaration of Religious Principle**: A text box stating that the BSA maintains that no member can grow into the best kind of citizen without recognizing an obligation to God and that the religious element in the training of the member, but it is absolutely nonsectarian in its attitude toward that religious element and the organization or group with which the member is connected shall give definite attention to religious instruction.
- Background Check Forms**: A text box stating that the three different background check forms must be torn off and each separately given to the applicant.
